Position Description

Applications for adjunct (temporary, part-time) positions are currently being accepted in order to create a pool of qualified candidates for both traditional on-site courses and/or online courses. The number of available positions varies from term to term. All persons recommended for employment must complete the required documents for employment. Applications for the Part-time Faculty Pool are accepted on an on-going basis

Minimum Requirements

- Master's degree in a scientific field; Doctoral degree preferred.
- Teaching experience is preferred. Courses that need adjunct instructors may vary by semester.
 Potential courses in need of instructors include: General Chemistry, Organic Chemistry,
 Biochemistry, Physics, Genetics, Anatomy & Physiology, Kinesiology, Environmental Policy,
 Environmental Ethics, Ecology, and other related fields.
