The best way to verify taxable income is by using the IRS Data Retrieval Tool on your FAFSA online. If you have not already used this tool, go to <a href="studentaid.gov">studentaid.gov</a>, log in, click 'Make FAFSA Corrections,' and navigate to the Financial Information section of the form. From there, follow the instructions to determine if you are eligible to use the IRS Data Retrieval Tool to transfer your 2019 IRS income tax information into your FAFSA.

If you are not given the option to use the IRS Data Retrieval Tool or choose not to use it, you must request your 2019 tax return transcript from the IRS and submit this to the WJU Financial Aid Office. To obtain an IRS tax return transcript, go to <a href="www.IRS.gov">www.IRS.gov</a> and click on the 'Get Transcript Online' or 'Get Transcript By Mail' links or call-1-800-908-9946. Request the "IRS tax <a href="return">return</a> transcript" and NOT the "IRS tax <a href="account">account</a> transcript." You will need your SSN, DOB and the address on file with the IRS.
