

Adjunct Professor – Psychology

Position Description

The Department of Psychology is actively seeking qualified adjunct professors to teach in the Traditional Undergraduate Psychology program.

Applications for adjunct (temporary, part-time) positions are currently being accepted in order to create a pool of qualified candidates for both traditional on-site courses and/or online courses. The number of available positions varies from term to term. All persons recommended for employment must complete the required documents for employment. Applications for the Part-time Faculty Pool are accepted on an on-going basis.

Minimum Requirements

- Master's Degree in Psychology, Counseling, or related fields
- Teaching experience preferred but not required. Courses that need adjunct instructors may vary
 by semester. Potential courses in need of instructors include: Educational Psychology, Human
 Diversity, Research Methods, Biopsychology, Psychological Testing, Cognitive Psychology, and
 Adolescent Psychology. Women and ethnic minorities are strongly encouraged to apply.
