GRADUATE COMMENCEMENT SPEAKER - CHAPLAIN EARL SMITH

Chaplain Earl Smith is an inspiring spiritual leader, motivational speaker, and author, best known for his transformative work as the Senior Chaplain for the San Francisco 49ers and Golden State Warriors. With over 35 years of experience, Chaplain Smith has touched countless lives through his commitment to providing spiritual guidance and mentorship to professional athletes, coaches, and staff. His dedication to fostering faith-based values in highly competitive environments has made him a trusted and influential figure in both the sports and faith communities.

Before becoming a chaplain for professional sports teams, Chaplain Smith served as the Chaplain of San Quentin State Prison. There, he played a critical role in the rehabilitation of inmates, offering hope and spiritual support to individuals in one of the country's most challenging environments. His work at San Quentin earned him widespread recognition for his courage, compassion, and the profound impact he made on the lives of those behind bars.

HISTORY OF JESSUP UNIVERSITY

Today's Commencement ceremony celebrates "What God has done, how awesome His works are on our behalf!" (Psalm 66:5). As we celebrate the lives of our graduates, we rejoice at the privilege to share in His work in our history, in our graduates' lives and in the future lives they impact.

Jessup University has a rich heritage with humble beginnings dating back to the Great Depression era when Eugene Sanderson saw the need for a Bible college in the greater San Francisco Bay Area. He purchased two large houses across from what is now San Jose State University.

During the next five years, he prepared for the future by improving the property and building a chapel that served the faculty and student body for many years. In January of 1939, Sanderson asked William L. Jessup to carry on the vision and start the college. On September 19, 1939, San Jose Bible College was established with a class of just 14 students.

Over the years, the University has been served by five other presidents including Al Tiffin, Woody Phillips, Chuck Boatman, and Bryce Jessup. It was during Dr. Bryce Jessup's tenure that the school became regionally accredited by WSCUC and moved its main campus here in Rocklin in 2004, when the university's name was changed to William Jessup University and now Jessup University.

Dr. John Jackson serves as Jessup University's sixth president. He holds a Ph.D. in Educational Administration and Organizational Studies from the University of California at Santa Barbara. His leadership has been marked with significant growth in numbers and reputation as we have simultaneously expanded facilities and program offerings to fulfill our mission.

In the midst of today's celebration, we pause to reflect. We see God's faithful hand over eight decades. We celebrate the past, are grateful for the present, and are confidently expectant of our future. God is calling us to His future and we are leaning into His call!

COMMENCEMENT HONORS

UNDERGRADUATE DEGREE CANDIDATE HONORS

Jessup University recognizes exceptional academic performance. Bachelor and Associate degree graduates who have completed at least 60 semester units at WJU are eligible for the following honors:

Summa cum laude 3.85 to 4.00 GPA
Magna cum laude 3.70 to 3.849 GPA
Cum laude 3.50 to 3.699 GPA

Bachelor and Associate degree graduates who have achieved at least a 3.75 GPA but who have not completed 60 units in residence with WJU may graduate "with distinction."

Undergraduate certificates and second bachelor's degrees are only eligible for "with distinction." Jessup GPA (exclusive of transfer) must be 3.75 or above.

All undergraduate honors students wear the gold honor braid, and Latin Honors wear the gold tassel with their regalia.

Honors in the commencement program are computed on grades through the fall semester for spring graduation, and spring summer semester for fall graduation. Honors designations are subject to change on the diploma once final grades have been submitted.
