

Biochemistry:


- In no less than 1,000 words, answer the following questions:

 - When did you decide that you wanted to be a teacher? Describe any experience that you have working in child development (volunteer, job related, church, or the private sector).

Computer Science:


- In no less than 1,000 words, answer the following questions:

Please choose one of the following options for your submission:

- 1. A creative writing piece Write either poetry or a short fiction story.
- 2. A historical and cultural analysis Use the following prompt for your essay: What 3 historical events in American history have had the greatest cultural impact on our nation?
- 3. A creative nonfiction piece Write a factual but creative piece about yourself or someone/something else.
- 4. For creative work, we recommend including a brief (1-2 page) rationale for the piece, explaining your creative process and goals.

Length Recommendations


Please adhere to the following length guidelines for your submissions:

- Short fiction: 5-10 pages
- Historical or cultural analysis: 5-10 pages
- Statement of interest: 2-4 pages
